## Our activities in Ukraine

**2015**

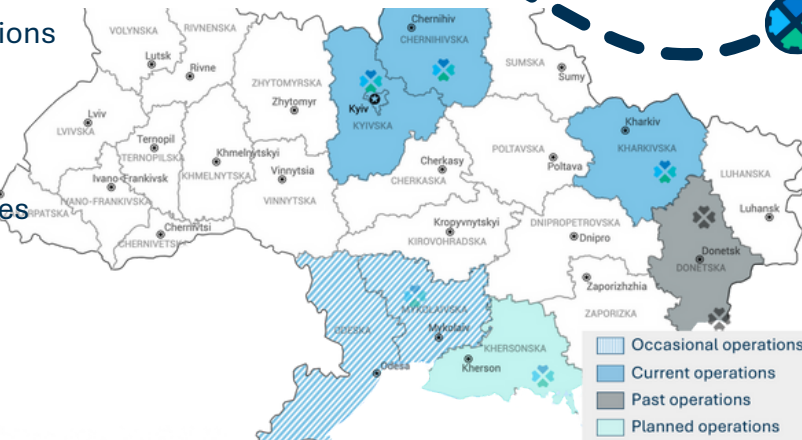
FSD's first operations in Ukraine. Risk education, survey and mine clearance activities are carried out in the Donbas.

**2022**

February: demining activities in the Donbas are suspended and emergency aid is set up. June: resumption of operations.

**2023**

As of 1 September, more than 200 FSD employees are active in the provinces of Chernihiv and Kharkiv.



### Since June 2022

- + 120,000 m<sup>2</sup> cleared
- + 100,000 people educated of the risks of explosive ordnance
- 1,297 explosive ordnance located

- 10** non-technical survey teams
- 7** explosive ordnance risk education teams
- 2** teams clearing collapsed buildings
- 2** clearance teams using specialised machines
- 1** remote controlled large loop detector team
